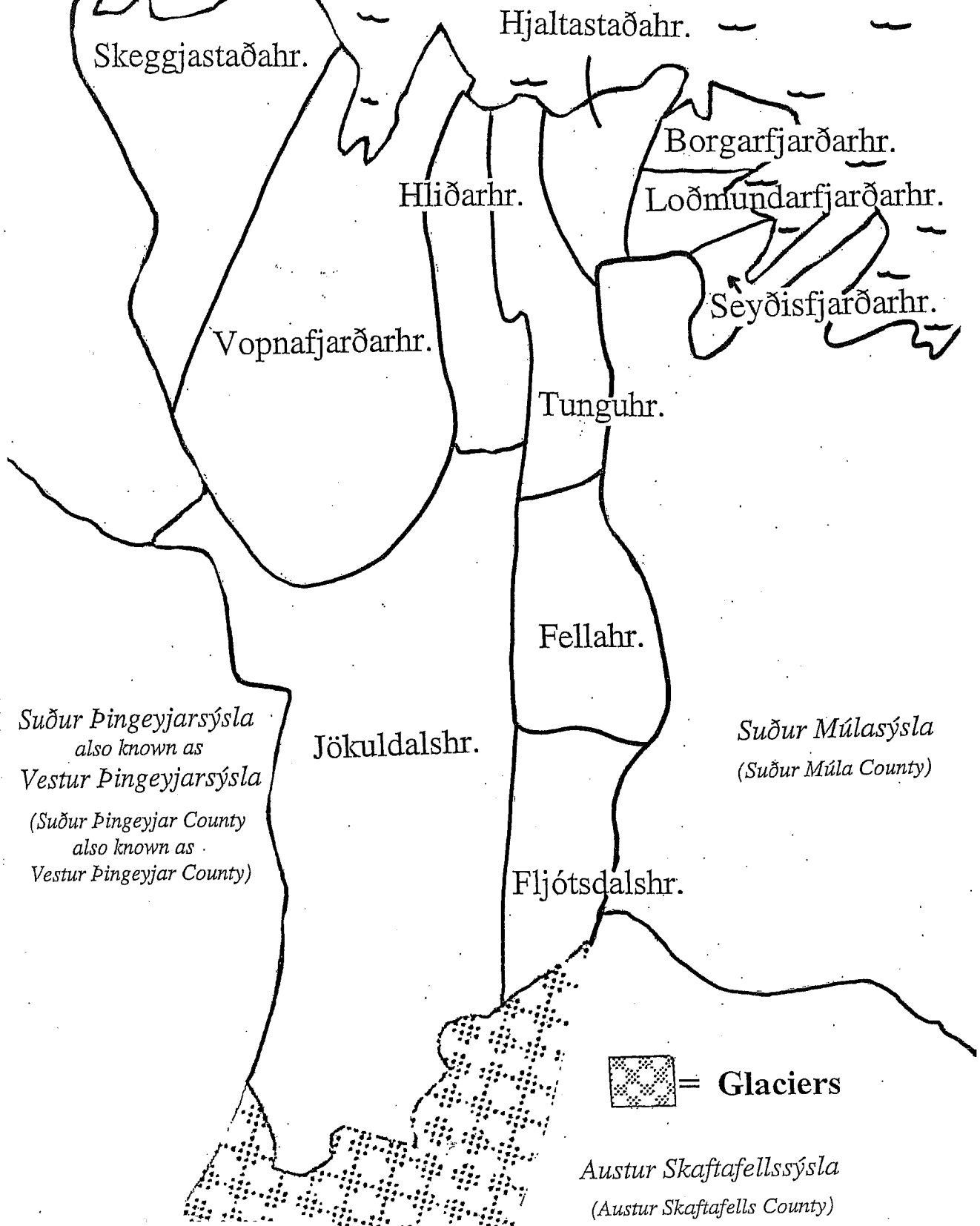

BÆJATAL Á ÍSLANDI 1961 [Reykjavík, 1961] (SCAND 949.12 E5b Copy 3), is Iceland as of 1961.

The Ísland Map (Icelandic Map) (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974) in the International (INTL) Map Case of the Family History Library (FHL) represents sýsla (county) and hrepp (district) boundaries as of 1974. This map may be represented at a different orientation from those shown on the Icelandic Map (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974).

Though some clerical districts (hreppur) may not be listed in the Family History Catalog (FHLC), they may appear on modern maps and on this included map.

Hlíðarhr. / Jökuldalshr

Hlíðarhr. is found on the Icelandic Map in the FHL INTL Map Case (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974) and in *BÆJATAL*, 55. According to Jonasson, *Tracing*, 45-46, it was part of Jökuldalshr. The Icelandic Map, FHL INTL Map Case (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974) shows Hlíðarhr. separate from Jökuldalshr.

Hróarstunguhr. / Tunguhr.

Hróarstunguhr. is found on the Icelandic Map FHL INTL Map Case (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974) but is not listed in the FHLC, *BÆJATAL*, or Jonasson, *Tracing*. The same geographic area is named Tunguhr. in Jonasson, *Tracing* 45-46. Tunguhr. is also the name used in the FHLC and *BÆJATAL*, 55. Tunguhr. is placed on this map instead of Hróarstunguhr. because it is in the FHLC.

Loðmundarfjarðarhr.

Loðmundarfjarðarhr. is named in the FHLC, in *BÆJATAL*, 56 and in Jonasson, *Tracing*, 45. It is not on the Icelandic Map, but is included within Borgarfjarðarhr. Loðmundarfjarðarhr. is shown on this map as represented in Jonasson, *Tracing*, 45.

Skeggjastaðahr.

According to the Icelandic Map in the FHL INTL Map Case (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974), Skeggjastaðahr. is the name for the same geographical location called Strandahr. in Jonasson, *Tracing* 45-46. Skeggjastaðahr. is in *BÆJATAL*, 54. It is not listed in the FHLC specifically, but under the parish of Skeggjastaðir, it is noted that parish records could be in any of three hreppur (districts). The names are not given.
