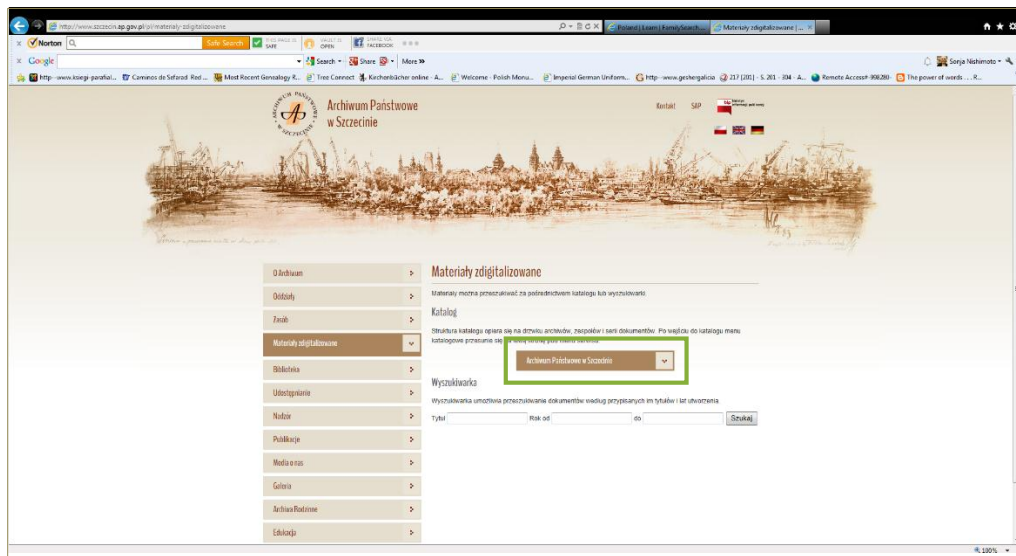


Using online Polish Records of Szczecin Part 2

1. Go to: <http://www.szczecin.ap.gov.pl>
2. Scroll down to the bottom of that page.
3. Click on **Materiały zdigitalizowane**
4. The following screen will appear
5. Click on the center drop-down screen, highlighted below.

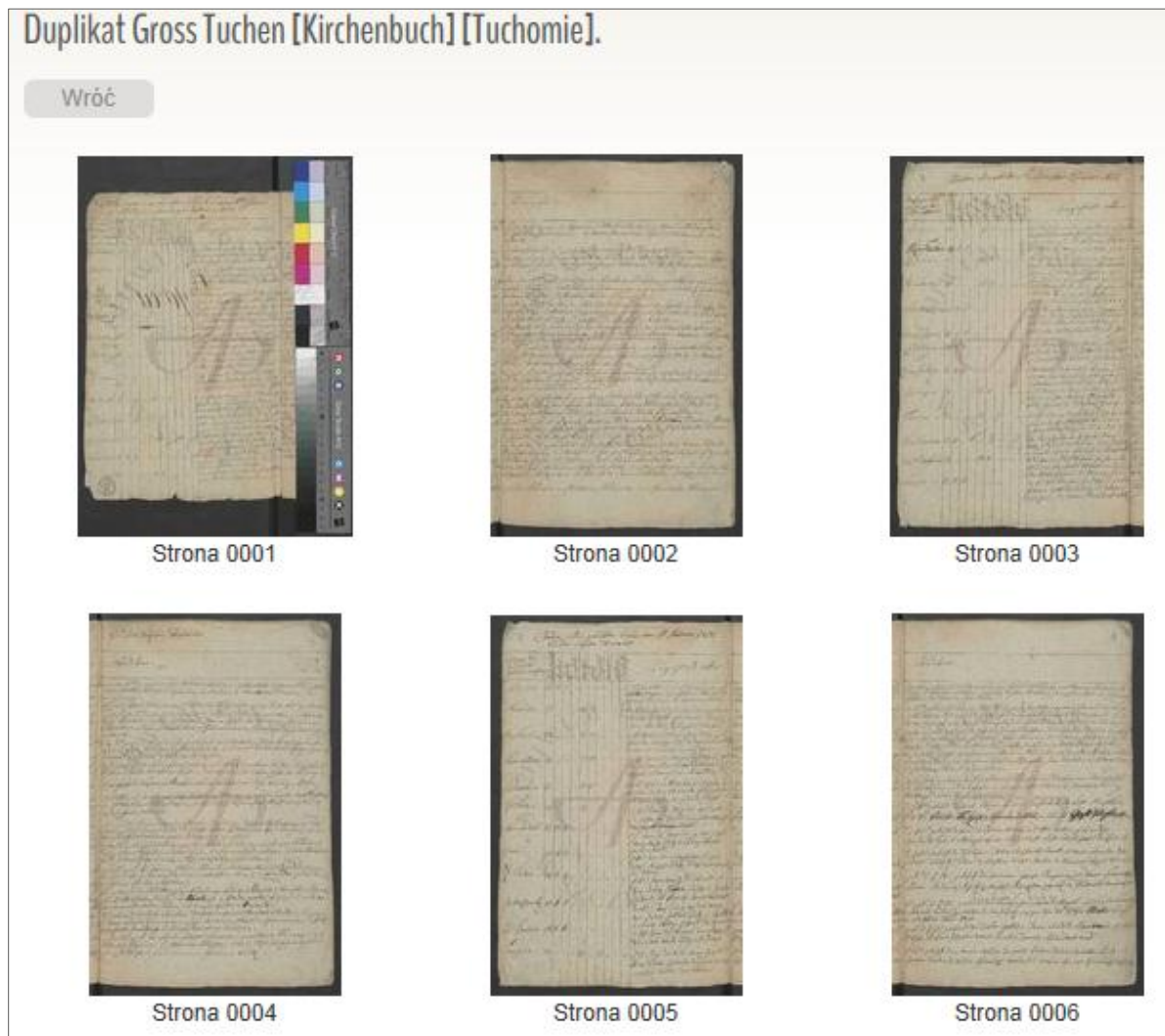


6. The digitized book options will appear. See screen below.



7. In the field which says “*Tytuł*”, type in the name of the parish village that you are looking for. You may use the German or Polish name of the location.

8. In the field which says “*Rok od*”, it asks you to type in the beginning year you want. In the following field which says “*do*” you would type the ending year. Example: from 1850-1875. If there are no records for the chosen time period, you will get no results at all. **Therefore, I have found it better to leave this field blank.**
9. As the book images appear, you will see that the description is in the original German text. You may need some help from Google translate to understand what is contained in the different books available.
10. After you find your book, click on the image of the book or on the far right on the word “*Szcegoly*” or even on the book description. All three places will open the digitized book.



11. The digital images will then appear. You will need to experiment a little to find the needed dates by opening the individual pages which are shown in chronological order.
