

Ancestry Trees and FamilySearch Family Tree


*NOTE: Tree sharing features are currently only available to LDS Ancestry accounts.

Ancestry Trees

- Each tree has an individual “owner,” who can invite guests, contributors and editors.
- Trees may be public or private: you may or may not be able to get to “good” info.
- An individual may be represented in any number of trees; life details may or may not match.

FamilySearch Family Tree

- One tree shared, sourced, edited, viewed by all.
- Each individual should be represented in the tree only once. Duplicate records should be merged.


