

DjVu is the most popular way to present publications in Polish digital libraries.
This short tutorial will explain how to view such files.



Click on „Show publication content” link.

File can be open in two ways: using built in aplet (Java Virtual Machine required) or using advanced DjVu browser. If you don't have any of that programs your internet browser will try to download publication file, but it will not open.

If you wish to download DjVu browser , you can click at the link located in second option. After program is downloaded and installed, please restart your internet browser and you will be able to view content, that you are interested in. Choosing this option you will be able to download digital books and view it offline.
