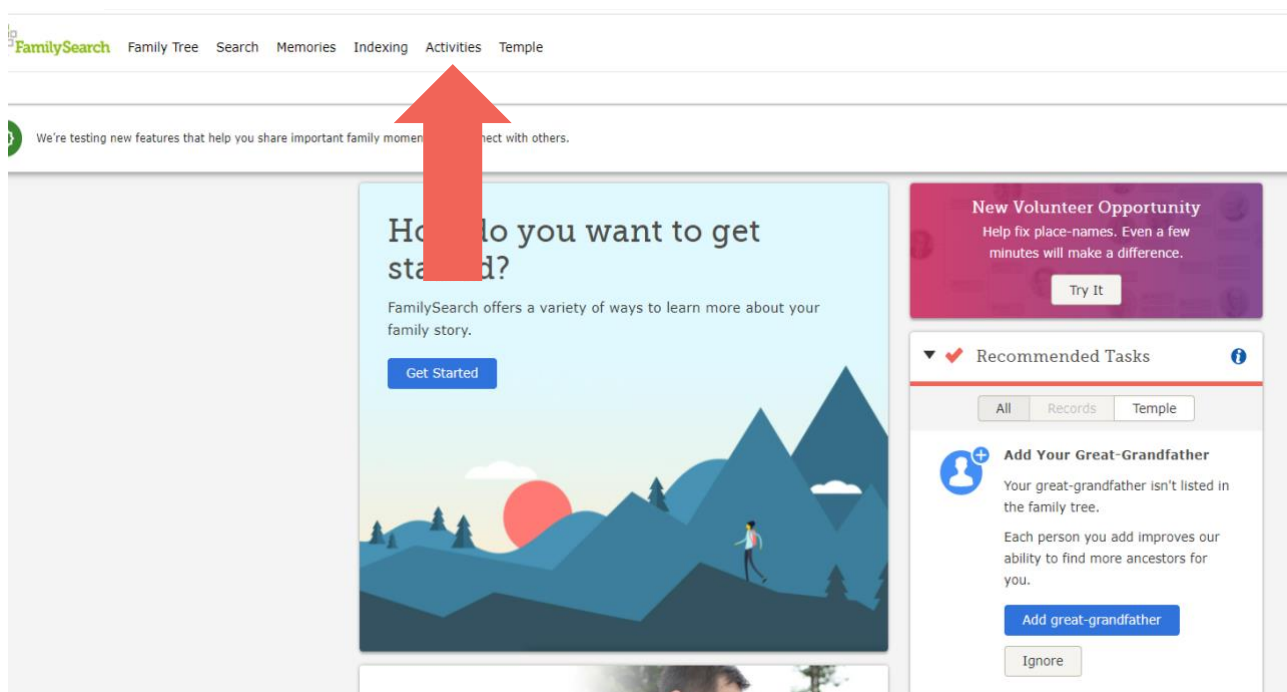

FamilySearch Activities

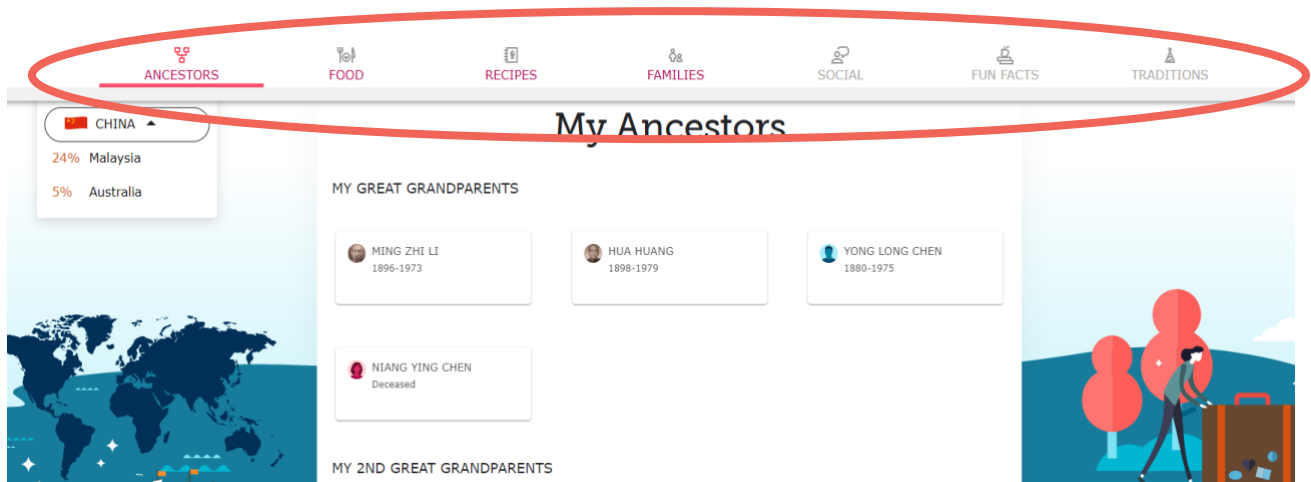
To access **Activities**, click **Activities** on the top of the **FamilySearch** homepage.



Where Am I From

This activity allows you to see where the people on your Family Tree are from.

- **Generations:** You can see where people on your Family Tree are from on a map. Drag the circles in the **# OF GENERATIONS** box on the bottom of the page to change the view.
- **My Family Lines:** This feature allows you to view the places on the map through one family line at a time. Just click on one parent on the left side of the page and follow the family lineage.
- **My Heritage:** This page shows the countries where your ancestors came from. Click on a flag to learn more about a particular country. You can explore different topics about that country, such as Ancestors, Food, Recipes, Families, Social, Fun Facts, and Traditions by clicking the topic buttons on the top of the page.



- **Timeline:** This page shows your family lineage according to timeline. You can change the timeline by dragging the circles in the timeline box on the bottom of the page.

Famous Relatives

This activity shows you if you are related to any famous relative.

All About Me

See what was happening in the year you were born. To change to the view of a different year, click on the **View a Different Year** button and choose an individual. This page covers topics such as: name meaning and origin, name popularity, popular song, science and technology, sports trivia and more.

Compare-A-Face

Upload a photo of yourself or take a new photo to see which ancestors you look the most like.

Record My Story

You can record audio recordings and save them on FamilySearch. You may choose suggested topics or create your own. After clicking on a topic, you will be prompted to speak. Click the microphone icon and start speaking. When you are finish, click the **DONE** button. Then click **SAVE** if you are happy with the recording or hit **CANCEL** if you want to delete the recording. If you would rather just type in your response, click **TYPE MY RESPONSE** and start typing you story in the box provided.

To see all your recorded stories, click **MY STORIES** on the top of **Record My Story** page.

Picture My Heritage

On this page, you can take a picture yourself in traditional costumes of your heritage.

In-Home Activities
