1) When was Henry Grow born?

Clue: **Find a book**

Pioneers and Prominent Men of Utah, part 2, p. 903

Call number: US/CAN 979.2 D3e

Location: **FHL Third floor** (end or west row of book shelves)

Answer:

This floor has lots of books, maps, pedigree charts, and computers. It has books about places in the United States and Canada. It has books about many religions, including Latter-day Saint history. It is a good place to look for information on ethnic studies and other cultures such as Native Americans, Jews, Afro Americans, Latin Americans, and more.

Look in the lobby by the Orientation room

4) What was Henry Grow's occupation in 1880?

Henry is listed in the 1880 U.S. Census living in Salt Lake City. The census taker asked him many questions about his family. What kind of work did Brother Grow do?

Clue: **Use the computer**

Go to www.ancestryinstitution.com, use the "Click here" link to get a list of records available. Then choose the 1880 United States Federal Census.

Type in:	Name: Henry Grow
	Born: about 1817/1818
	Residence: Utah

Double click on the name to see more information.

Double click on the image to see the actual census record and find the answer.

Answer:

- 5) Henry Grow's ancestors came to the United States from Württemberg, Germany.

What is the word for father in German?

Clue: **Go to the International Floor on B1**

Go past the Access Service window to the copy center.
Find the turning display rack which contains many publications.
Look for the one called "German Word List."
Look up the word "father" in English to find the German word.

Answer:

B1 is the International Floor where books and microfilmed records from many countries are available. Staff members who help patrons can read and write many different languages.
