REXBURG -- Margaret LaRae Pickett King Clarke, 78, of Rexburg, died Oct. 19, 2007, at Madison Memorial Hospital of causes incident

to age.

She was born Feb. 22, 1929, in Logan, Utah, but lived in Ammon during her years in elementary and high school. She received a bachelor's

degree from Ricks College in Rexburg and was a four-year graduate with the second class to receive a bachelor's degree from that school (1947-1951). Her major was speech and drama with a minor in English and secondary education. She pursued graduate studies at Fresno State, the University of California at Santa Barbara and the University of Hawaii.

She was honored as Outstanding Junior College Teacher of the Year by the National Education Association and the California Teacher Association in 1966. She was a teacher at Porterville High School and college in California for 12 years. Prior to this, she taught at Sugar Salem High School in Sugar City, Idaho.

She taught for four years at BYU-Hawaii, serving as the Department Chairman of the Speech and Drama Department two of those years. Her husband, LeRoy King, died in Laie, Oahu, Hawaii, in 1969.

Returning to Ricks College in 1970, she was a teacher in the Communications Department. That same year, she married John L. Clarke. In 1971, they were called to preside over the New England Mission for three years.

After their mission, President Clarke retired and LaRae returned to Ricks College to work as the Associate Dean of Student Life for 20 years. At Ricks, she was honored as an Elect Lady of Lambda Delta Sigma, Exemplary Woman of the Year and Exemplary Administrator of the Year.

She received the Golden Gleaner award and has served as a President in the Relief Society, Primary and MIA. She taught in the various auxiliaries and served on the Relief Society and MIA Stake Boards.

She is survived by her children, William Christopher (Debbie) King of Sequim, Wash., Laurel (Brent) Dalling of Hamer and Tamara (Val) Davies of Rexburg; stepchildren, Renee' Scott and Ann (Pete) Thompson, both of Rexburg, and John R. (Colette) Clarke of Blackfoot; siblings, Gayle Jacobson of Swan Valley, Marilyn Hunter and Beth (Gordon) Thatcher, both of Rexburg, Richard (Myrna) Pickett and Matt Pickett, both of Idaho Falls, Berdene (Brent) Hill of Blackfoot, and Glayson (Joyce) Pickett of Shelley. She is also survived by 17 grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by two husbands, a daughter, her parents, three brothers and one sister.

Funeral services will be at 3 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 24, at the Rexburg LDS 15th Ward. The family will visit with friends from 6:30 p.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday at Flamm Funeral Home and from 2 p.m. to 2:45 p.m. Wednesday before services at the church. Burial will be in the Rexburg Cemetery.
