Give a reason, then click <i>Finish Merge</i>.</li> </ul>	<p>Add parents Importance of research</p>

Two duplicate Henrys will appear.</li> <li>Click on <i>Review Merge</i> for the <u>first duplicate</u> Henry.</li> <li><u>Add or Replace</u> correct information. <u>Add his duplicate spouse</u>.</li> <li><u>Add his two children</u>.</li> <li>Click <i>Continue Merge</i>. Give a reason, then click <i>Finish Merge</i>.</li> </ul>	<p>Replace name to remove ( ) Add missing information Add a duplicate spouse Add children</p>

Merge Nancy (Spouse of Henry)	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><u>Highlight and copy of the ID number of the second spouse Nancy</u>.</li> <li>Click on the first Nancy's name. (the Nancy with the children)</li> <li>Open her person details page by clicking on <i>PERSON</i>.</li> <li>Click on <i>Possible Duplicates</i>.</li> <li>Click on <u>Merge by ID</u>.</li> <li>Paste in the ID number of the second Nancy. Click <i>Continue</i>.</li> <li><b>Click on Switch Positions.</b></li> <li><u>Add or Replace</u> correct information and relationships.</li> <li>Click <i>Continue Merge</i>. Give a reason, then click <i>Finish Merge</i>.</li> </ul>	<p>Merge by ID Switch positions Replace an identical record Add children</p>
