
This class will show you how Metasuche can help you find information about your ancestors. These sources can speed up your research time and help you find new information regarding your ancestors.

STEPS

1. Type in the URL www.genealogy.net or www.compgen.de. Both will take you to the same site
2. Notice the yellow toolbar on the home page of the site. Look for the term, Metasuche and click there. It is in the red box as shown below: You can view this in German and English.

3. Choose which databases you would like to use. Remember that the more are checked and the more common your surname, the program will take longer to respond. Occasionally a common name may cause the program to freeze or have long delays. Check or uncheck the databases you want as shown below:
