## New to the Menu Ribbon

Find a FamilySearch Center or affiliate library near you.

## Test New Features

Try the new home page layout. Toggle it on and off in the upper-right. Provide feedback on the left.

- Find friends (if they've set their info as public)
- Tasks
- Recents

Test the new person page. Toggle between the new and old in the upper-right. Provide feedback on the right.

## FamilySearch Blog

New records are added every week. Scroll to the bottom of any page to find the link to the blog or go to [www.familysearch.org/blog](http://www.familysearch.org/blog). Click on **Categories** and then "What's New at FamilySearch."

## Historical Records

Checking out what's been added. Make sure you're signed in to see the most collections.

1. Click **Search** and then **Records**.
2. Find **Browse All Collections**.
3. Click on **Last Updated** twice to sort by most recent.
4. Filter on the right by collections that contain images, collection type, place, and/or date.
