The Ísland Map (Icelandic Map) (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974) in the International (INTL) Map Case of the Family History Library (FHL) represents sýsla (county) and hrepp (district) boundaries as of 1974. This map may be represented at a different orientation from those shown on the Icelandic Map (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974).

Though some clerical districts (hreppur) may not be listed in the Family History Catalog (FHL), they may appear on modern maps and on this included map.

Hvanneyrarhr. / Siglufjarðarkaupstaður

Hvanneyrarhr. is found in Jonasson, *Tracing*, 48. On the Icelandic Map in the FHL INTL Map Case (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974) and in *BÆJATAL*, 44, the same geographic area is named Siglufjarðarkaupstaður.

Þóroddstaðahr. / Ólafsfjarðarkaupstaður

Þóroddstaðahr., which was found in Jonasson, *Tracing*, 48, is not on the Icelandic Map or in the FHL. On the Icelandic Map in the FHL INTL Map Case (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974) and in *BÆJATAL*, 44, it is named Ólafsfjarðarkaupstaður.
