

EXHIBIT B: Authorization Form

<p>I (interviewee), _____, have provided (1) the information in the pedigree chart and accompanying audio/video recording (“Recording”) and (2) original records and photographs (“Original Records”) and digital images (“Digital Images”) of the same (the Recording, Original Records, and Digital Images are collectively referred to as the “Pedigree”). The information I have provided is accurate to the best of my knowledge.</p>

I represent and warrant that I have been informed of and understand the purposes for which FamilySearch International (“FSI”) is collecting the Pedigree and the information therein, which purposes (“Purposes”) include preservation, publication, facilitating access, promoting family connections and understanding, and advancing and facilitating genealogical and family history research. I further represent and warrant that FSI has made the following disclosures to me: (i) the name and contact address of FSI as the data controller: Michael Colemere, 50 E North Temple Street, Salt Lake City, UT 84150 USA; (ii) the non-compulsory nature of FSI’s request to collect and use my personal information and FSI’s inability to lawfully digitize and publish the information if I fail to comply with such request; (iii) my rights as a data subject under the Zimbabwe Data Protection Act (“DPA”), including: (a) the right to be informed about the purpose(s) for collecting and using my personal data; (b) the right to access my personal information in FSI’s custody; (c) the right to object at any time, by request and without charge, to FSI’s continued use of my personal information; (d) the right to correct any false or misleading personal information; and (e) the right to have deleted any false or misleading personal information; and (iv) that any personal information collected as part of the Pedigree will become freely accessible to any person who accesses FamilySearch.org or FSI’s related applications.</p>
<p>2. I have authorized the creation and use of my image and voice in the Recording, the digital copying of the Original Records, and the creation of the Digital Images. I acknowledge and agree that I will not receive any compensation for any rights or licenses granted or for any grant of additional rights.</p>

I hereby grant to FSI a royalty-free, irrevocable, worldwide, non-exclusive, transferable license to publish, reproduce, modify, adapt, translate, create derivative works from (including electronic indices), distribute, perform, display, and use the Pedigree, or any part thereof or information therein, including any information considered sensitive under the DPA (“Sensitive Data”) that I choose to provide to FSI, perpetually and on a definitive basis, for any lawful purpose, without limitation, including publication or exhibition on the internet for full public access so that FSI and its users, licensees, successors, assigns, and affiliated entities can access and download for genealogical research purposes. I understand that under the DPA, Sensitive Data broadly refers to information or opinions relating to the following categories of personal data: (i) racial or ethnic origin; (ii) political opinions; (iii) membership in a political association; (iv) religious beliefs or affiliation; (v) philosophical beliefs; (vi) membership in a professional or trade association; (vii) membership in a trade union; (viii) sex life; (ix) criminal, educational, financial, or employment history; (x) gender, age, marital status, or family status; (xi) health information; (xii) genetic information; and (xiii) any information that could be considered to present a major risk to a data subject’s rights.</p>

I represent and warrant that, for any personal identifying information, including Sensitive Data, that I have provided about persons other than myself that are still living (“Third Parties”), I have obtained informed consent from them to disclose that information to FSI and to the use of information for the Purposes as outlined in this Authorization Form. I further represent and warrant that the Original Records were legitimately acquired by me, are original records, and do not infringe third-party rights.</p>

I hereby grant permission to FSI to collect, maintain and transfer to the USA (or any other country that may have less stringent data privacy laws than my country) the Pedigree and all information therein. I consent to this collection, use, processing, disclosure, and transfer of personal identifying information for the Purposes and to FSI’s retention of such for as long as necessary to meet the Purposes.</p>
<p>6. I represent and warrant that I have the necessary authority, power, and licenses to agree to and grant to FSI all rights, licenses, and authorities set forth herein, including, without limitation, those described in paragraph 3.</p>
<p>7. I represent and warrant that the contents of this form have been clearly and accurately explained to me in a language that I understand and that I fully comprehend them. I understand that I may seek information regarding rights in and access to information, including the right to withdraw consent to process personal information, through FSI at dataprivacyofficer@familysearch.org.</p>
