Czechia “How to” Guide, Beginner Level: Answer Key

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Use *Mapy.cz* to answer the following questions for each location. Start in Basic map view.

1. Enter “**Kutna Hora**” into the search box and answer the following questions:

Does the town name have diacritics? If yes, which letter(s) include diacritics?	a (Kutná Hora)
What district and region does this town belong to?	District: Kutná Hora Region: Central Bohemian
How many inhabitants does the town have?	21,000 (see paragraph above Wikipedia link)
What is the historic name of this town? Hint: Select the 19 th century map.	Kuttenberg

2. Search for the town of **Zábřeh** and answer the following questions:

Which villages are administrative parts of Zábřeh? Hint: See the Wikipedia paragraph.	Dolní Bušínov, Hněvkov, Pivonín and Václavov
What is the historic name of Zábřeh?	Hohenstadt
What is the distance (using the manual measurement tool) between Hohenstadt and Kniefke (Hněvkov)?	around 4.19 km
Would travel between these two towns be direct (on a straight line)?	No. The area is hilly and roads wind around them following the river.

3. Answer the following questions about **Wenzelsdorf**:

What is the modern (Czech) name for this location? Hint: It is a vanished settlement.	Bývalý Václav (A vanished village. Find an interpretive panel in the photo gallery to see an historic photo of the village.)
What is the distance (using the manual measurement tool) between Wenzelsdorf and Pleš to the northwest?	around 1.5 km
What is the historic name of Pleš?	Plös (note the large settlement shown on the historic map)
