



Norður Ísafjarðarsýsla (Norður Ísafjarðar County)

This map was created from the following sources, each source representing boundaries and location names from different years.

BÆJATAL Á ÍSLANDI 1961 [Reykjavík, 1961] (SCAND 949.12 E5b Copy 3), is Iceland as of 1961.

The Ísland Map (Icelandic Map) (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974) in the International (INTL) Map Case of the Family History Library (FHL) represents sýsla (county) and hrepp (district) boundaries as of 1974. This map may be represented at a different orientation from those shown on the Icelandic Map (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974).

Though some clerical districts (hreppur) may not be listed in the Family History Catalog (FHLC), they may appear on modern maps and on this included map.

This sýsla (county) may also be known as Austur Ísafjarðarsýsla, but in Jonasson, *Tracing*, 47, it is Norður Ísafjarðarsýsla, as it is in *BÆJATAL*, 32, the FHLC, and on the Icelandic Map in the FHL INTL Map Case (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974).

Eyrarhr. / Ísafjörður

Eyrarhr. is identified in Jonasson, *Tracing*, 47 and in *BÆJATAL*, 32.

It is not found in the FHLC or on the Icelandic Map. Instead a city (kaupstader) called Ísafjörður is found in its place on the Icelandic Map in the FHL INTL Map Case (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974).

Grunnavíkurhr.

Grunnavíkurhr. is identified in Jonasson, *Tracing*, 47, in *BÆJATAL*, 32 and in the FHLC. It is not found on the Icelandic Map in the FHL INTL Map Case (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974).

Sljettuhr. / Sléttuhr.

Sljettuhr. is not listed in the FHLC or on the Icelandic Map in the FHL INTL Map Case, but is found in Jonasson, *Tracing*, 47. In *BÆJATAL*, 33 it is spelled as Sléttuhr.
