The Ísland Map (Icelandic Map) (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974) in the International (INTL) Map Case of the Family History Library (FHL) represents sýsla (county) and hrepp (district) boundaries as of 1974. This map may be represented at a different orientation from those shown on the Icelandic Map (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974).

Though some clerical districts (hreppur) may not be listed in the Family History Catalog (FHLC), they may appear on modern maps and on this included map.

Broddaneshr.

The FHLC does not show Broddaneshr. as a hrepp (district). The Icelandic map (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974) in the FHL INTL Map Case also does not show Broddaneshr. as a hrepp. It is also not listed in *BÆJATAL*.

However, Broddaneshr. was listed in Jonasson, *Tracing*, 48. It was located where Fellshr. and Óspakseyrarhr. are represented on the Icelandic Map located in the FHL INTL Map Case (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974).
