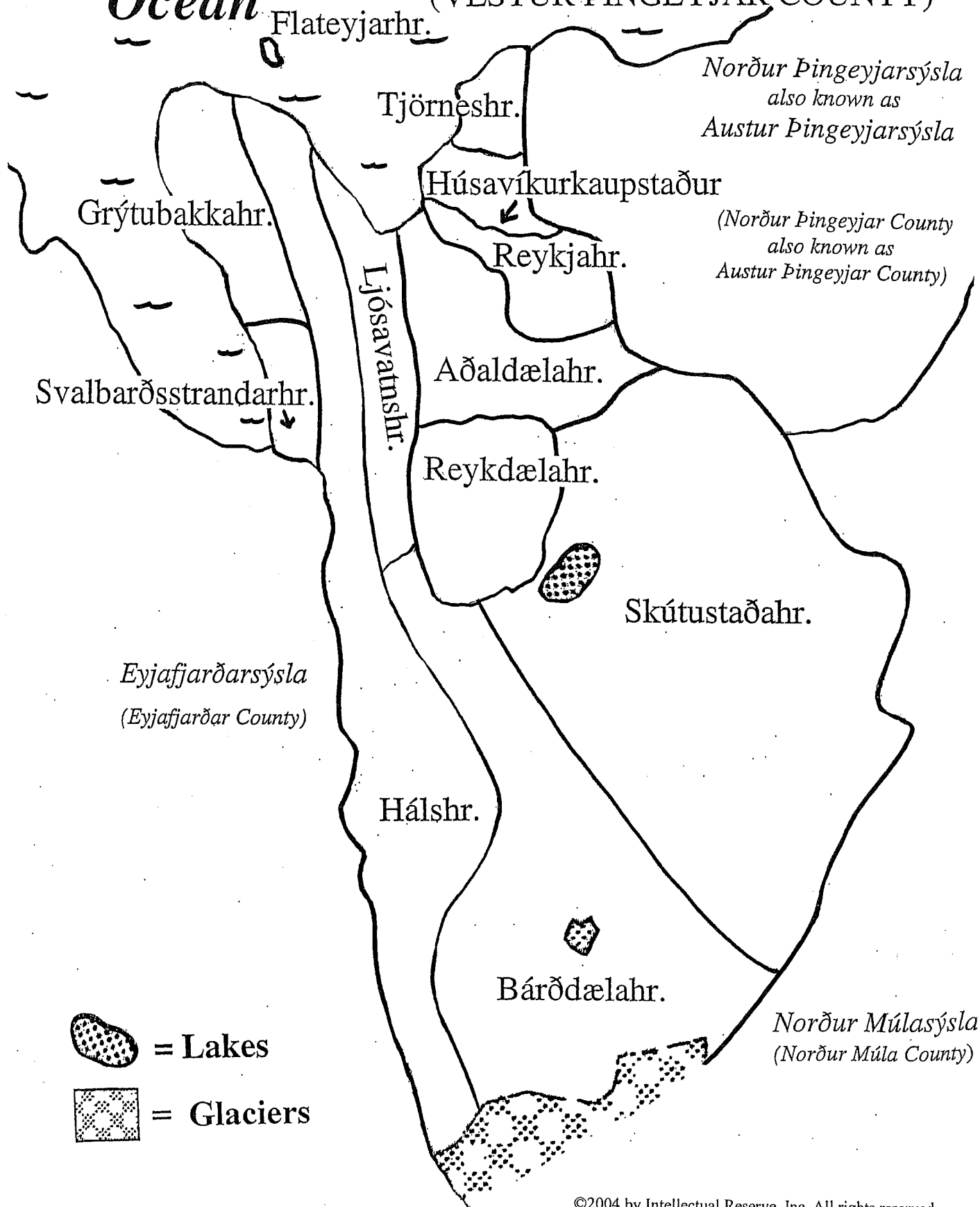

BÆJATAL Á ÍSLANDI 1961 [Reykjavík, 1961] (SCAND 949.12 E5b Copy 3), is Iceland as of 1961.

The Ísland Map (Icelandic Map) (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974) in the International (INTL) Map Case of the Family History Library (FHL) represents sýsla (county) and hrepp (district) boundaries as of 1974. This map may be represented at a different orientation from those shown on the Icelandic Map (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974).

Though some clerical districts (hreppur) may not be listed in the Family History Catalog (FHLC), they may appear on modern maps and on this included map.

Flateyjarhr. / Flatey

Flateyjarhr., an island north of Hálshr., is identified in the FHLC and in *BÆJATAL*, 49 but not on the Icelandic Map in the FHL INTL Map Case. According to Hálfðánarson, ed., *Be on the safe side*, 24, and also a map located in the FHL INTL Map Case called Ísland (Tourist Association of Iceland SCAND> Map Case 949.12 E7t 1963), the same island is called Flatey. The FHLC refers to a parish called Flatey. This parish is described as being in Flateyjarhr.

Helgastaðahr. / Aðaldælahr.

Helgastaðahr. found in Jonasson, *Tracing*, 48 is not in the FHLC, on the Icelandic Map, or in *BÆJATAL*. Aðaldælahr. is the name given for this area on the Icelandic Map in the FHL INTL Map Case (FHL 949.12 E7i 1974).

Húsavíkurhr. / Húsavíkurkaupstaður

This location is identified as Húsavíkurkaupstaður in the FHLC.
