



How to Search in DTU Digital Library

Find **DTU Digital Library** - <http://digitallibrary.dtu.dk> - via the DTU Library page at www.portalen.dtu.dk.

Type in the words you want to search for. **[AND]** will automatically be added between the words just like Google does. The use of many words or phrases will narrow the result.

Too many hits?

If you get too many hits please add extra words or phrases in the search box.

You can limit your search to a specific document type, (Articles, Journals, Books, Student Theses) by using the right side of the screen.

Looking for a specific title or phrase?

If you are looking for a specific title (Articles, Journals, Books, Student Theses) enter the title with quotation marks, i.e. **"Introduction to food process engineering"**.

If you are looking for a specific subject or phrase, please enter the phrase with use of quotation marks, i.e. **"stirling engines"**

Looking for a specific journal title?

If you are looking for a specific journal title use the **[Advanced Search]**

Choose **[JOURNALS]** & write the journal title in the box, tick off **[EXACT MATCH]** & press **[SEARCH]**

Use of wildcards or truncation

Use asterisk [*] as a wild card for **one or more characters**. The term **comput*** will search words like **compute, computing, computer, computers, computation**.




Question mark [?] can be used as a wild card/truncation to match **one character only**. A search for **machine?** will provide a search result **with hits containing machine and machines**, but not hits containing machinery.

The [?] can be used in the middle of a word, i.e. civili?ation – and will find both civilization and civilisation.

Use of operators

You can use boolean operators to specify your search.

The operators must be written with capital letters **AND - OR – NOT** like in Google.

	Search for [solar AND energy] , means that both words needs to be present in each record.
	Search for [solar OR energy] , means that at least one of the words needs be present in each record.
	Search for [solar NOT energy] , means that solar needs to be present but not energy.
