Further to our correspondence discussing the possibility of partnering with One Laptop per Child, this is to confirm that CARE International Gulf of Guinea (Ghana/Togo/Benin), an NGO, is willing to partner with you to offer 100 XO laptops to 200 children classified as "agents of change" this summer in Ghana.
