Antarctic Legacy Project database

Thank you for using our database. It contains historical and personal information about South Africa's activities in the Antarctic and Sub-Antarctic region since the official start of South Africa's involvement there, during the middle of the 20th century. There are 4 ways to use the database:

- Search for your own topic of interest using the site's search facility at the top of the page.
- Use the site's search facility and enter a keyword from our list
- Browse the database by using the defined categories e.g. Photo Gallery. Select which region you are interested in (SANAE, Marion or Gough), then choose the decade, or other options as applicable
- Limit your search to a specific area of the database by clicking on a region, decade or other option and then using the search facility at the top of the page.
