REGISTRATION 2014 – FIRST YEARS

By registering themselves from **14 January 2014**, newcomers can avoid long queues.

Any computer with Internet access (www.mymaties.com) may be used. Students who do not have access to a computer may make use of the computer-user area that will be made available on the Stellenbosch Campus especially for this purpose.

Username and password: Use the username and password that have been mailed to you.

Computer-user area: Neelsie Students' Centre (See map – B)

Date: 20 Jan to 28 January daily from 08:00 to 16:00. (excluding 25, 26 Jan)

> Students who do not register electronically (e-Registration) have to follow the normal registration programme.

> Students who are not yet registered when the normal NARGA registration ends on 28 January, will have to pay a late registration levy of R500-00.
