Intro:

The Pilot program OER aims to give the opportunity to agricultural experts to promote the outcomes of their own experiments to all interested people, enhancing the transfer of agricultural knowledge from theory to practice.

Objectives:

The aim of the course is to acquire basic knowledge and skills on the utilization of Information and Communications Technology (ICT) and especially of web2.0 tools in describing agricultural experiments. Specifically, the training content addresses the following objectives:

- Description of the agricultural experiments with an easy and understood way, in order to transfer the agricultural knowledge to practitioners or citizens without any specific agricultural background
- Online tools in agriculture
- Social networking and agri-online communities (Facebook giannis)
- Sharing creative commons works
- Wiki pages editing and formatting
- Photo and video sharing policies
- Searching for education resources in agricultural topics
- E-learning platform for agricultural topics (agriMoodle)

Outcomes:

By the end of the course the participants will have grown a plant and they will have learned to use web2.0 tools

The task:

During the training you will be required to grow a plant. You should use some web 2.0 tools in order to describe your experiment. The main tools that you will use are Blog, Wiki, Agrimoodle and Flash Meeting.

- Blog (<http://blog.oergrowers.gr/>) - weekly use – It will be used to post the progress of your project.
- Wiki (http://wiki.oergrowers.gr/index.php/Main_Page) – It will be used by the end of the training to present your agricultural experiments.
- agriMoodle (<http://agrimoodle.agroknow.gr/>) - It will give you access to all training material.
- Flash Meeting (<http://flashmeeting.e2bn.net/>) – It will be used for your weekly online sessions.
- YouTube (<http://www.youtube.com/>) – It will be used for uploading and sharing your videos.
- Flickr (<http://www.flickr.com/>) – It will be used for finding photos or uploading your own photos.
