CONTENT

- ◉ Intro

INTRO

- On OER Growers blog (blog.agroknow.gr) you should add images only by embedding them from flickr
- You should never upload a photo from your computer.

FIND A PHOTO

- ◉ Go to the individual page of the picture you want to add
- ◉ You can add both yours and others photos

Embed only creative commons licensed photos

CHOOSE SIZE

- ◉ If you're logged in and it's your picture, you should see a magnifying glass on top labeled "all sizes"
- ◉ After the first click, Flickr will probably show you the "Large" view, which is too big to fit nicely in our blog template. So next, click where it says "Medium":

GET THE CODE

- Copy the html code
