Labour Market Access Program for Newcomers Living with a Disability

Catchment Area: Region of Peel

Eligibility for Services and Support:

- ❖ 16 years and older
- ❖ Living in the Region of Peel
- ❖ Newcomer with a disability that is physical, emotional, cognitive (diagnosed or otherwise)
- ❖ No referrals needed
- ❖ Provide Landing Document or Permanent Resident Card

Services and Support Provided:

- ❖ Integration into the community through needs based referrals
- ❖ First meeting is always at an FSP office but subsequent meetings may be held at a community setting close to client's home
- ❖ Follow-up on applications, interventions and advocacy of clients
- ❖ Increase client's knowledge of Canadian Labour Laws, the Canadian Labour Market, and the Job Market in Canada and the Region of Peel
- ❖ Job search techniques and strategies, job placements and on-the-job coaching
All participants are invited to attend workshops on various topics ranging from Labour Market Information to Employability Skills training. The participants also receive one-on-one Job Coaching, meaning if they find a job as part of this program we will support them on-the-job by participating in their orientation, training and some of their scheduled work shifts if the participant requests.)
- ❖ Enhance their social networking and access to available resources.
- ❖ Volunteer / unpaid and paid job placements
