Step 1: Comprehensive Ranking System

Assessment Criteria	Candidates	Spouses or Common-Law Partners
> Skills & Experience Factors	500 Points	460 Points
> Spouse or Common-Law Partner Factors	N/A	40 Points
> Skills Transferability Factors	100 Points	100 Points
> Additional Points (Job Offer or Provincial Nomination)	600 Points	600 Points
Grand Total	1200 Points (Maximum)
