Labour Market Access Program for Newcomers Living with a Disability

If you:

- Are a newcomer to Canada,
- Are a resident of the Region of Peel,
- Have a disability,
- Are 16 years of age or older,

Then you could be eligible for the Labour Market Access (LMA) Program for Newcomers Living with a Disability.

The LMA Program for Newcomers Living with a Disability includes:

- Supporting eligible newcomers to become employable, irrespective of their disabilities.
- Providing job coaching and job development support.
- Providing workshops and information about the Canadian Labour Market.
- Facilitating integration into the community and the Canadian Labour Market.
- Participation in the program for 12 to 20 weeks, as per the client's needs.

Labour Market Access Program for Newcomers Living with a Disability

This program will help newcomers to:

- Increase their knowledge of Canadian Labour Laws, the Canadian Labour Market, and the Job Market process in Canada and in the Region of Peel.
- Facilitate their integration into Canadian Labour Market and society.
- Receive job coaching, job development and support.
- Improve their job readiness and employability skills.
- Enhance their social networking and access to available resources.
