I have now consulted colleagues on the request you make below. I regret that we are not inclined to grant you further access to the course material and archived forum postings. You were previously granted access firstly to prepare your appeal letter, which was initially submitted to the Director, and subsequently, and exceptionally, granted further access to provide you with an opportunity to provide any amendment to that letter before it was considered by the disciplinary panel.
