

# Blogging Checklists

Below you will find two different checklists that can be used when blogging. One gives a more complete outline of expectations and the other simply a reminder. Find out what works best for your kids and use it! Remember that the key to good blog posts is modeling.

## My Blogging Checklist

- ✓ Did I write a catchy title that will entice people to read my post?
- ✓ Did I give a complete thought that met the requirements of my teacher?
- ✓ Did I include details or evidence to support my thinking on the subject?
- ✓ Did I proofread my post/comment before submitting it to be published?
  - ☐ I checked the spelling and used the spell check feature
  - ☐ I checked my sentences to ensure they end with the correct punctuation (. ! ?)
  - ☐ I checked all the proper nouns, my title and the beginning of all my sentences to assure they have a capital letter
- ✓ Did I use correct grammar?
  - ☐ I checked to make sure I used complete sentence
  - ☐ I checked to make certain that I had no run on sentences
  - ☐ I checked and there are no words that I use too much
  - ☐ I checked to ensure my point can be clearly understood
- ✓ Did I do my very best work?
