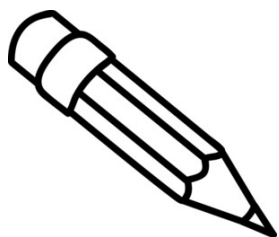

In this semester long art course you will be introduced to the artistic process teaching you to be creative, to solve problems, and to think critically. You will explore various two-dimensional and three-dimensional media including drawing, painting, mixed media, and sculpture. You will be exposed to a variety of artists, cultures, and styles. You will reflect on your work through writing and assess your work using the Studio Habits. At the end of each project several students' work will be chosen to be exhibited in the school and on our school website. Those students will also receive a Most Creative Artist Award certificate.

Grading and Evaluation:

- Daily Effort (40 %)
- Improvement/Projects (40 %)
- Test/Homework (20 %)

Daily Effort:

You can earn up to **8** points a day for the following:

- On time to class or late with a note*
- Prepared with materials
- In uniform (no outerwear)
- Respectful to peers and adults
- Follow directions first time given
- Stays focused and on task
- Participates in Clean-Up (2 points)

You will earn a weekly Effort grade based on the average of daily effort grades. This grade will be posted to PS on Friday.

Grading and Evaluation (continued...)

Homework:

Every Friday you will be assigned an Art Journal assignment. You will have 1 week to complete the assignment. You will be graded on 3 things:

- Did you complete the assignment (what was asked)?
- Do you have a focal point or area of emphasis?
- Did you fill the page or draw to the edges?

If you do not have your assignment, you will earn a zero.

You will have other periodic homework assignments throughout the semester.

Deadlines and Late Work Policy

Each project will have a deadline. The final deadline or hard deadline will be announced one week prior.

After the final deadline has passed, you will have **ONE** week to complete your project in **tutorial after school**. If the work is turned in incomplete, points will be deducted.

You will assess your work in process and at the end of the project according to the Studio Habits of Mind along with a written reflection.
