I. Sentence

- a. A group of words that expresses a complete thought.
- b. A fragment does not express a complete thought.
 - 1. Does not have either a subject or a predicate
- c. Always begins with a capital letter

II. Types of Sentences

- a. A declarative sentence makes a statement
- b. An interrogative sentence asks a question
- c. An imperative sentences gives a command. It ends with a period.
- d. An Exclamatory sentence expresses a strong feeling. It ends with an exclamation point (!)

III. Parts of a Sentence

- a. The Subject is what the sentence is about
 - 1. The simple subject includes the main words
 - 2. The complete subject includes all the words that tell us whom or what the subject is about.
- b. The predicate tells us what the subject does
 - 1. The simple predicate is the main word(s)
 - 2. The complete predicate includes all the words.
