Enrique's JOURNEY: All Facts or A Mixture of Facts and Opinion

Enrique's JOURNEY is a true story, or a work of nonfiction. But even true stories may have a mixture of fact and opinion.

A fact is something that everyone would agree is true. It might be an event, a number, a date, or a specific location where something occurs.

An opinion is something that people may disagree or view differently. It could be an emotion, a feeling, an idea, or a judgment about people and whether their actions or choices are positive or negative. It may use the words, should, would, or could.

Example:

Fact: *Bill Januson lost his job as a welder when the auto plant downsized.*

Opinion: *Bill should stop mentioning how much money he used to make on the assembly line because it doesn't help him with feeding his children or paying bills.*
