# THINK ABOUT IT

- How did else did geography influence the economic development of colonial regions?
- New England Colonies: many mountains, thick with trees and rivers. The forest provided, large amount of lumber for New England and led them to specialize in shipbuilding industry. Landscape was unsuitable for cereal crops and growing season was short, so had to rely on imports. They could trade fish, whale products, fur, ships and timber.
- Middle Colonies: fertile soil and milder climate led to larger farms and cash crops; availability of natural resources led to small-scale manufacturing, lumbering, and mining; good ports allowed trade.
- Southern Colonies: Long growing season and fertile soil allowed for small farms and plantations. Most plantations were on the Tidewater: flat, low -lying plains along the seacoast.
