

The Future

1. The Future is the tense that describes actions that take place in the future (actions haven't happened yet)
2. The Future uses the infinitive form to create its stem
3. The stem is formed by cutting off the -re of the infinitive
4. There are two groups of endings for the future:

a. 1st and 2nd Conjugation endings:

<u>Person</u>	<u>Sing</u>	<u>Pl</u>
1st	-bo	-bimus
2nd	-bis	-bitis
3rd	-bit	-bunt

1st Conjugation: amo, amare, amavi - to love

<u>Person</u>	<u>Sing</u>	<u>Plural</u>
1st	amabo - I love will love	amabimus - we will love
2nd	amabis - you love will love	amabitis - y'all will love
3rd	amabit - he/she/it love will love	amabunt - They will love

2nd Conjugation: moneo, monere, monui - to warn

<u>Person</u>	<u>Sing</u>	<u>Plural</u>
1st	monebo	monebimus
2nd	monebis	monebitis
3rd	monebit	monebunt
