1. Neuter nouns of The 2nd Declension - pgs. ~~4, 5, or 6~~ 4, 5, or 6

5. Neuter nouns of The 2nd declension have some special features:

- i. The nominative singular ends in '-um'
- ii. The nominative and accusative plurals both end in '-a'
- iii. The nominative and accusative forms in The singular and plural are exactly The same.

Ex. templum, -i, n. - temple

<u>Case</u>	<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
Nominative	templ <u>um</u>	templ <u>a</u>
Genitive	templ <u>i</u>	templor <u>um</u>
Dative	templ <u>o</u>	templis
Accusative	templ <u>um</u>	templ <u>a</u>
Ablative	templ <u>o</u>	templis
