1. Personal pronouns are the pronouns used to indicate The 1st, 2nd, and 3rd persons.
2. In English, as in Latin, personal pronouns will change their forms based on their function in the sentence.

Ex: I see the dog. The dog sees me.

ego canem video. Canis me videt.

nos - we

mei - of me/mine

nostri - of us/ours

Dative

mihi - to/for me

nobis - to/for us

Accusative

me - me (d.o.)

nos - us

Ablative

me - x

nobis - x

### 2nd Person

#### Singular

#### Plural

Case:

Nominative

tu - you (subj.)

vos - y'all (subj.)

Genitive

tui - of you/yours

vestri - of y'all

Dative

tibi - to/for you

vobis - to/for y'all

Accusative

te - you (d.o.)

vos - y'all (d.o.)

Ablative

te - x

vobis - x
