## The Nominative

1. The Nominative case is The Subject of The sentence.

2. It will always be The subject of a verb/action

Ex. puer scribit: "the boy writes"

Mundus vertit: "The world turns"

Scintilla filiam vocat: "Scintilla calls her daughter"

3. The nominative answers The question:

"Who/what is (verb)ing?"

Ex. "Who writes? The boy writes"

"What turns? The world turns"

4. A nominative noun can be translated into English as "a noun, the noun"
