













Changes in Life During the Neolithic Period

(3) Write a justification of why you placed the tokens in the order you did. (4) Write a two-sentence summary describing how the changes in each aspect of life affected daily life in the Neolithic period.

Aspect of Life	Paleolithic	Neolithic	Effect on Daily Life
Food Supply Justification: Domestication comes from selective breeding. People would not want horns (danger) but would want wool.			Increased food supply means not everyone has to search for food all the time. Free time goes up in addition to surplus (extra) food.
Occupations Justification: During the Neolithic revolution people moved away from hunter/gatherer jobs and started making things.			People are no longer limited to hunting and gathering jobs. They start following hobbies or pursuing other things, like toolmaking or basketweaving.
Population/Settlement Justification: Not having to follow animals for hunting caused people to live in large, permanent settlements.			As more people discover the ease of Neolithic living, settlements get larger. Communities are close because of proximity.

Aspect of Life	Paleolithic	Neolithic	Effect on Daily Life
Resources Justification: The paleolithic necklace was made with resources left over from where they were. The neolithic necklace has shells and beads, possibly from trade.			Interest in resources that were not in the immediate area led people to travel. Trade increased.
Shelter Justification: Permanent settlement meant people could live in more complex houses (with rooms and levels) instead of collapsable tents.			Houses were more comfortable and provided more protection from the elements. They were also more complex, with windows, stairs, and multiple levels.
Technology Justification: New materials and methods made making tools, like weapons, easier and more useful.			New innovations were often made by accident but led to a more comfortable lifestyle.
