

EGYPTIAN GODS AND GODDESSES

Poster Project

Over the next week, you will be working with your nome to create a poster that represents one of the gods or goddesses important to ancient Egyptians. Your poster must have the following parts:

- title
- an outline to guide your research
- a paragraph for each member of your nome
- at least one picture
- a properly formatted MLA works cited page (we will discuss how to do this)

Your nome is responsible to, **together**, plan both the layout of your poster and create an outline for the information that will be on your poster. You must work **together** to create a complete works cited page for all the information on the poster. You **individually** will be responsible for completing one of the paragraphs on the poster. Your nome can provide suggestions and plan, help locate resources, or proofread your writing, but you will take primary responsibility for one paragraph.

Paragraph

Your paragraph should be clear, concise, and have solid content taken from reliable resources. If you have background information you learned elsewhere, you must find it in a citable resource in order to include it in your paragraph. The information in the paragraphs on your poster must be in your own words. You must paraphrase and may not use quotes. You must use at least two resources and both must be correctly listed on your works cited page. Your name should be at the end of the paragraph for which you are responsible.

Grading

This poster project will count as a **test grade** for Q2. Here is how your grade will be calculated:

- 40% will be assigned to your nome based on your group work (outline, layout, works cited)
- 40% will be assigned based on your individual paragraph
- 20% reflect your focus, behavior, and group work in class

You will be given class time to work on your poster with your nome, but your nome may also decide to assign each other homework. Your poster must be assembled and ready to turn in at the end of class on **Thursday, January 8.**
