Committee work:

- I recommend putting all written work in Times New Roman 12 font.
- Single space.
- One paragraph.
- Cite your sources. Use a simple reference such as (1), (2), etc. This goes in the text and then again at the bottom of the page where you give your source. In most cases, simply put the URL. That is sufficient. Example:

George Washington was the first president of the United States (1).

- Print out hard copies of your two (one for each topic) paragraphs.
- Bring a three-ring binder with *all* of your materials inside. This will keep everything in place. You will want your background guide; *two copies* of each position statement (one for the judges); and any notes.

REMEMBER: *This is a learning experience. The most important action you can take is to come and have fun, listen and learn. Do not worry about having the best position statement in the universe. Just come to learn if Model UN is something you might enjoy. That is what matters most of all.*
