Your four options are

- Write a song, rap or poem related to the book and write a paragraph explaining why you chose your subject (character, theme, etc.)
- Write and draw a picture book about a key scene and write a paragraph explaining why you chose that scene
- Write and draw a storyboard about a key scene (12 squares) and write a paragraph explaining why you chose that scene
- Write a five-paragraph academic essay about some aspect of the book
