

Character Brain Map

For this assignment, you will create a visual representation of what you think occupies the thoughts of your character in *Macbeth*. **This assignment is due Monday, February 6th.**

To successfully complete this assignment, you should:

1. Think about your character's personality traits, motivations, actions, and temperament. What does he/she want? What kind of a personality does he/she have?
2. Draw/sketch the character's brain/ head.
3. Now fill the character's head with thoughts. The thoughts can be things that they love, hate, want, fear, or anything else you can think is pertinent. You can use quotes, images, or just write down thoughts they might have. Remember to write/draw the things the character thinks about the MOST the LARGEST, and the things the character thinks about the LEAST the SMALLEST.
5. Use at least one quote that this person has said that you think represents their identity or goals (make sure to use quotation marks, i.e. "Double, double toil and trouble")
6. For a good example of a brain map, please see the next page, "Inside the Mind of Kanye West".

This assignment will be scored out of 10 points based on the following criteria:

- **Content (6 points):**
 - Is it an accurate portrayal of this character's thoughts?
 - Is it based on things that the character said or did in the play?
 - Do the thoughts take up different portions of the brain based on how much the character thinks about them?
- **Presentation/ Organization (4 points)**
 - Is your character brain map well organized and clear?
 - Did you put effort into making your character brain map?
