21.	exterior	<i>(adjective)</i>	suitable for use on outside surfaces (as of a house).
22.	scenery	<i>(noun)</i>	the array of impressive natural prospects and imposing features of a particular place.
23.	opponent	<i>(noun)</i>	an adversary : a foe.
24.	allowance	<i>(noun)</i>	an amount of money that is given in reimbursement and is to be used for personal or household expenses.
25.	committee	<i>(noun)</i>	a group of people delegated to consider, investigate, or act on and usually to report on some matter or business.
26.	bulletin	<i>(noun)</i>	a brief public notice concerning a matter of marked current interest and usually issuing from an authoritative source.
27.	hoarsely	<i>(adverb)</i>	in a rough or harsh-sounding manner : gratingly.
28.	automated	<i>(verb)</i>	converted to operation by mechanical or electronic devices that take the place of human labor.
29.	subdivision	<i>(noun)</i>	a tract of land surveyed and divided into lots for purposes of sale.
30.	heralded	<i>(verb)</i>	greeted especially with enthusiasm : hailed.
31.	appointed	<i>(verb)</i>	assigned, designated or set apart by authority.
32.	regents	<i>(plural noun)</i>	people who govern kingdoms when the sovereigns are not able to govern because they are too young or ill or are away.
33.	infraction	<i>(noun)</i>	a violation by failure to follow, observe or obey.
34.	Pacific	<i>(adjective)</i>	of or relating to the ocean extending from western North America and western South America to eastern Asia and Australia.
35.	affirmation	<i>(noun)</i>	an act that confirms, validates or asserts something as true : a positive assertion.
36.	cipher* or cypher	<i>(noun)</i>	a method of transforming a text in order to conceal its meaning by substituting or rearranging letters.
37.	administration	<i>(noun)</i>	performance of executive duties : management.
38.	geometry	<i>(noun)</i>	a branch of mathematics that deals with the measurement, properties, and relationships of points, lines, angles, surfaces and solids.
39.	consecutive	<i>(adjective)</i>	one right after the other often with small intervening intervals.
40.	scavenger	<i>(noun)</i>	an organism that typically feeds on refuse or carrion.
41.	defensiveness	<i>(noun)</i>	the quality or state of having or showing a tendency to react aggressively to any real or imagined criticism.
