<p>Odd or unnatural in shape, appearance, or character; fantastically ugly or absurd; bizarre.</p>	<p>A severe or witty reply, especially responds to someone's statement, argument, etc.</p> <p>To reply to, usually in a sharp way.</p>
<p>Brilliantly or excessively showy</p> <p>Cheaply showy in a tasteless way; flashy.</p>	<p>Lacking in fineness or delicacy of texture, structure, etc.</p> <p>Lacking delicacy, taste, or manners; rude or crude.</p>
<p>At a distance, especially in feeling or interest; apart.</p> <p>Reserved or reticent; indifferent; disinterested.</p>	<p>Strict or exact in the way one acts or conducts his or herself.</p>
<p>Lacking in variety; tediously unvarying; All the same</p> <p>Characterizing a sound continuing on one note or sound.</p>	<p>To frighten with threats, violence, etc.; intimidate; overawe.</p>

<p>To torment with, or as if with, the sight of something desired but out of reach; tease by arousing expectations that are repeatedly disappointed.</p>	<p>Finery in dress, especially when showy, gaudy, or the like</p>
