Guidelines for Group Project Slideshow

Directions: You and your group members will put together a slideshow using Google Slides that you will present to the class on Monday of next week. The presentation will sum up the research you did about your book's disability or condition as well as its portrayal in your text. You will divide the work equally between each other, but you will want to practice your presentation as a group. Please read over the guidelines and rubric for this portion of the group project.

Guidelines

- Address all of the questions in the research packet as well as the additional text questions included on this document
- Limit the number of words on each slide -- please do not write full paragraphs on these slides!
 - You should have brief bullet points that you can use to guide what you present to the class instead of writing out what you plan to say word-for-word
- Proofread for typos, misspellings, and unclear wording
- Make the slides visually appealing and clear to the viewer

Additional Text Questions -- Answer as a group

- 1) **Summarize the plot** of your book. Also, **explain how** the disability or condition affects the conflict.
