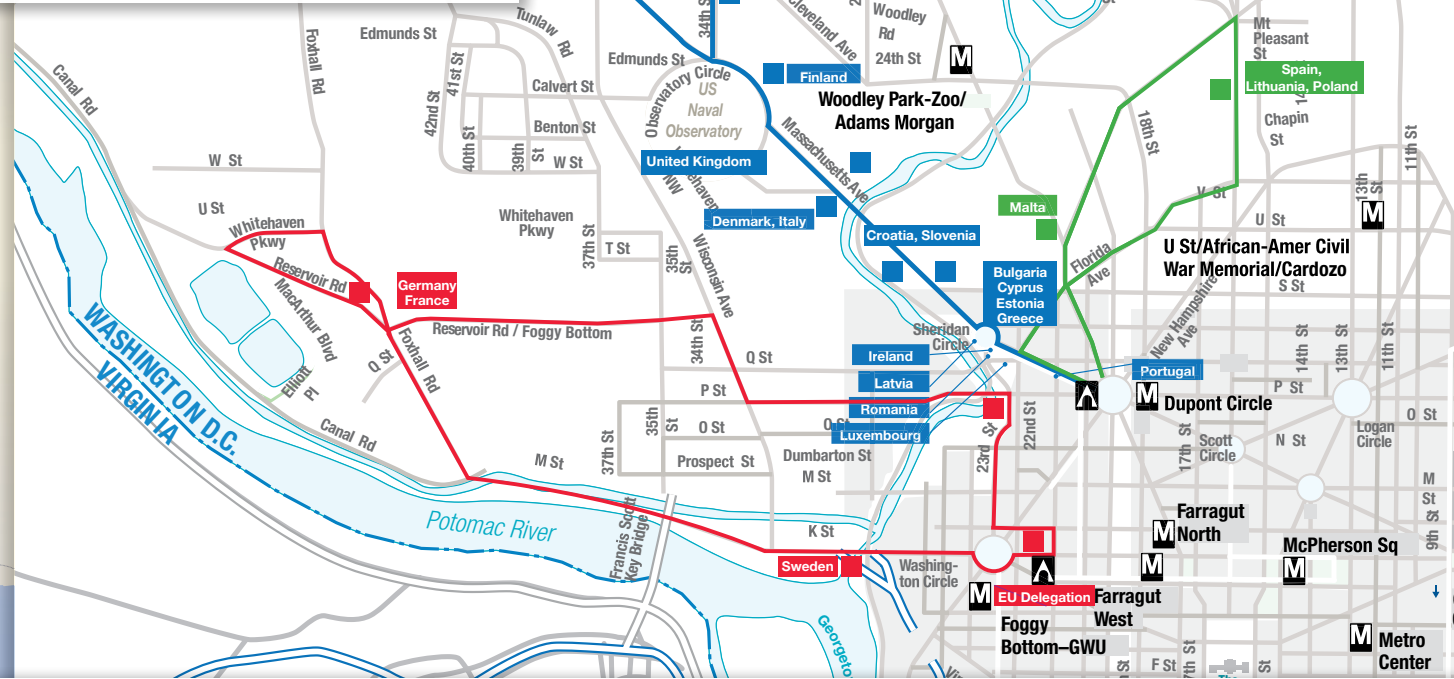
Red route (Reservoir Rd.)
