i. On it's own, (as a pronoun) hic, haec, hoc means "this one" or "this man/woman/thing"

Ex. Quintus lupum videt. Quintus hunc ~~videt~~ timet.

"Quintus sees the wolf. Quintus fears this thing."

ii. With a noun (as an adjective) hic, haec, hoc means "this + noun"

Ex. hic puer = this boy      haec ~~est~~ hiems = This winter
