*Savage Fortress* by Sarwar Chadda

Your options are

- Write a script for a key scene from the book
- Write a song or poem related to the book
- Write an alternate ending for the book
- Write the first chapter of a sequel to the book
- Write a key part of the story from a different character's point of view
- Write and draw a picture book about a key scene
- Write and draw a storyboard about a key scene (12 squares)
