

# Vocabulary Sort: miss, mit

transmit	to leave out; to not <b>send</b>
intermission	to <b>send</b> someone out; to let someone leave
mission	to " <b>send</b> " yourself under someone else's control; to give in to someone else's power
dismiss	to <b>send</b> out or give off (such as an odor)
submit	a special duty or function which a person or group is <b>sent</b> out to do
remit	to <b>send</b> someone in; to allow someone to enter
emit	a weapon designed to be <b>sent</b> in the direction of a target
missile	a break between acts of a play or performance during which people are <b>sent</b> out for snacks or stretch breaks
omit	to <b>send</b> back (usually related to paying bills)
admit	to <b>send</b> something across places; to pass along
