Out of the four options below, please pick two to conjugate and translate fully:

- a. lavo, lavare - to wash
- b. terreô, terrêre - to frighten
- c. pingo, pingere - to paint
- d. operio, operire - to cover

Verb #1: lavo, lavare (1st conjugation)

Infinitive forms:

Latin Form	English Translation
lavare	to wash

Present Tense:

Person	Singular (Latin and English)	Plural (Latin and English)
1st	lavo - I wash	lavamus - we wash
2nd	lavas - you wash	lavatis - y'all wash
3rd	lavat - he/she/it washes	lavant - They wash

Imperative forms:

Number	Latin Form	English Translation
Singular	lava	wash!
Plural	lavate	wash!

Verb #2: pingo, pingere (3rd conjugation)

Infinitive forms:

Latin Form	English Translation
<u>pingere</u>	<u>to paint</u>

Present Tense:

Person	Singular (Latin and English)	Plural (Latin and English)
1st	<u>pingo - I paint</u>	<u>pingimus - we paint</u>
2nd	<u>pingis - you paint</u>	<u>pingitis - y'all paint</u>
3rd	<u>pingit - she/he/it paints</u>	<u>pingunt - They paint</u>

Imperative forms:

Number	Latin Form	English Translation
Singular	<u>pinge</u>	<u>paint!</u>
Plural	<u>pingite</u>	<u>paint!</u>
