Scene 1:

Narrator: There was once a woman.

Mother: (enter) (sew)

Narrator: She was sewing and she pricked her finger on a needle.

Mother: Ouch.

Narrator: Three drops of blood fell onto the snow below the ebony framed window. It made her want a child.

Mother: If only I had a child whose lips were as red as blood, skin as white as snow, and hair as black as ebony. And I would name her Snow White.

Narrator: A year later her wish came true.

Mother: Oh, Snow White, you are so beautiful.

Narrator: However, the mother died a few hours later. The father was sad, but he married another woman whose name was Evana.

Evana: (Enter) I am Evana. I am evil, don't tell my husband. (Maniacal laughs) (exits)

Scene 2:

Narrator: Evana had a mirror and everyday she asked it:

Evana: Mirror, Mirror on the wall, who is the fairest one of all?

Narrator: Everyday the mirror replied:

Mirror: You

Narrator: The Queen was always flattered by this. But 12 years later, on a very ordinary day, she began to doubt the mirror. She dined alone one morning with Snow White.

(Snow White enters)

Evana: (enter with fried chicken) Good morning. (in a fake nice voice)

Snow White: Good morning, mother. Isn't it a lovely day? (sweetly)

(sit in silence)

Snow White: Mother, would it be possible to have a birthday party this year? I have a few friends in mind that I would like to invite.

Evana: Absolutely not! Don't you know you are not allowed to have friends in MY house? I can't believe you would think that was OK.

Snow White: Fine, mother, be like that. As Shakespeare would say, "My soul is full of discord and dismay."

Evana: You've been reading *Hamlet*! This nonsense must stop at once.

Snow White: But why? As it says in *Moby Dick*-

Evana: Don't ever quote or read books in my house again!

Snow White: As you wish. I'll read on the front steps. (storms off)

Evana: (narrows eyes and rushes up staircase)

Narrator: The queen was becoming suspicious. She went upstairs to ask the mirror a question she had not asked in a while.

Scene 3:

Evana: Mirror, mirror, on the wall, who is the fairest one of all?

Narrator: The mirror began to give its normal response, but strangely paused.

Evana: (angrily) Answer me! Now!

Narrator: The mirror finally did respond and it confirmed Evana's suspicions.

Mirror: You still are quite fair, my queen. But I am afraid to say that Snow White is the fairest one of all.

Evana: (taken by rage) I will kill her! I will chase her through the apocalypse, to the end of the world and the great outer sea! Curse you, oh mighty mirror! (Screams in rage and attempts to break mirror but does not succeed) Oh, that hurt!

Scene 4:

Narrator: The queen, in her rage, immediately called upon her finest huntsman.

Evana: Huntsman!

Huntsman: (enter) Yes, your majesty?

Evana: Take Snow White into the woods and kill her!

Huntsman: Yes ma'am.

Evana: And bring me her internal organs so that I know you have done the task.

Narrator: The huntsman obeyed the queen's orders and took Snow White into the woods.

Huntsman: Come with me Snow White, let us take a walk in the woods.

Snow White: Ok. Why do you have your bow?

Huntsman: For protection.

Narrator: They went far enough into the woods that the huntsman thought it was safe to kill her.

Snow White: Oh what lovely flowers.

Narrator: When Snow White stopped to look at the flowers, a piggy starts to squeal. The huntsman notices it.

(The Huntsman draws and points the bow at Snow White. At the last minute he points the bow to the piggy. The piggy squeals.)

Huntsman: (To Snow White) I spared your life. Go! Run!

Narrator: The Huntsman brought the piggy's organs back to Evana. Evana ate the organs for dinner thinking they were Snow White's.

Scene 5:

Narrator: Snow White wandered through the forest for many days. At last she gave up and sat down to cry.

Snow White: (Cry)

Narrator: A few hours later she looked off into the distance and spotted a tiny house. She ran towards it.

Snow White: What a tiny house. I wonder if anyone lives there.

Narrator: She knocked on the door.

Snow White: Is anyone home? (Peer through window)

Narrator: The door opened but Snow White did not see anyone standing there.

Grumpy: (cough, cough) I am down here, fool. Don't be such a doofus.

Snow White: (looks down) Oh! Sorry. Is your mamma home?

Gumpy: Listen you! I am 20 years old. Have you ever heard of a dwarf?

Snow White: I am afraid not. My evil stepmother has never let me out of the house except when I had to go to school.

Grumpy: Oh. How did you get here?

Snow White: Well, my mother told our huntsman to kill me but he killed a piggy instead.

Sleepy: Grumpy, who are you talking to?

Grumpy: This girl who has never heard of a dwarf.

Sleepy: Just let her in.

Snow White: Thank you. By the way, my name is Snow White.

Grumpy: Weird.

Narrator: Snow White told her story to the dwarves and they agreed to let her stay with them. The next day they went to work.

All Dwarfs: Do not let anyone in whatever you do.

Scene 6:

Narrator: Back at the palace, the queen asked the mirror:

Evana: Mirror mirror on the wall who's the fairest of them all?

Mirror: Snow White is still the fairest, she lives in the forest with the seven dwarves.

Evana: I must kill her, the huntsman did not do his job.

Narrator: The queen decided to disguise herself as an old woman, and go to the seven dwarves house.

Scene 7:

Narrator: Evana hid behind a tree across from the seven dwarfs house. Before she approaches the house she transformed herself into an old woman with a basket of apples.

Evana: (Knocks on the door) Hello, help a poor old woman

Narrator: Snow White did not heed the words of the dwarves, but instead she let the old woman in.

Snow White: I am really hungry. Can I have one of your apples?

Evana: Of course, here is a nice fresh one that I picked, take this one

Narrator: The minute Snow White bit into the apple she fell dead. The old woman laughed and hurried away. When the dwarves came back they put Snow White in a glass container and cried over her for several days.

Dopey: I wonder why she didn't listen to us.

Grumpy: She owed me a piece of her dessert, now I'll never get it. Humph!

Sleepy: (Yawns) I'm actually happy for her. She gets to sleep a bit now.

Happy: Look on the bright side! She was a good companion.

Sneezy: Ahh-choo!

Doc: Will you all shut up? I thought that if you liked her, you would honor her funeral. It's too bad I never got to present to her the Dwarf Rap.

Bashful: I never even met her. I was too busy hiding.

Scene 8:

Narrator: The dwarves continued to go to work for many years, but eventually abandoned the house and moved to the faraway mountains. They came back every year to honor Snow White, but eventually grew old, and the journey became more arduous. They planned on going only once more before their death and it was on this day that a miracle would occur, as a young prince was riding nearby.

Prince: (enter) I see a bunch of old people over there, I'll go check it out. (he rides over) Ooh, snap! I like that young lady!

Grumpy: She's dead, idiot.

Prince: I don't care! (kisses Snow White)

Snow White: (wakes up) Who are you? (slaps Prince)

Prince: I am Prince Not-As-Charming-As-You-Might-Think. Come with me to my castle.

Snow White: Of course.

Narrator: So they lived happily ever-

Doc: Wimpy phrase! We end with the dwarf rap! (Does the Dwarf Rap)

Dwarf Rap: Yo what's up?
I'm Doc
If you want me to knock
Then go hit the flock
I go mining, singing
Go to work
If you don't like it
Then go to church
There's Happy, Grumpy

Dopey, Bashful,
