

ENGLISH 5 VOCABULARY REVIEW STORY

Directions: We have learned 148 vocab words this year! There were fifteen lists of 10 words each. There were two words that appeared on two lists. Thus, 148 words. The definitions are available on Ms. Mujal's wiki page.

1. Your mission is to write a creative story using *AS MANY* of the words as you can.
2. The words should make sense; don't force it. Show that you know what the words mean when you use them. You may use related forms of the words. For example, the adverb *dismally* rather than the adjective *dismal*. Or the noun *description*, rather than the verb *describe*.
3. **UNDERLINE** the words when you use them and count them. You may only count a word once, even if you repeat it. Put the number of words you used at the top of the first page inside a circle.
4. You will write a draft of your story, revise and edit that draft, and then create a final version. Turn in your revised and edited draft and your final version.
